

In 1904, Esáasi Eweera, the last native Bubi leader who opposed the Spanish rule at the current island of Bioko, Equatorial Guinea, was detained by colonial guards and died three days later. By reenacting written texts through voiceovers, taping and studying native oral accounts and identifying historically charged sites, *A Storm Was Coming* reflects on the gaps, contradictions and falsehoods that colonial history is built upon.
